COURTHOUSE RULES

I. DRESS CODE

A. Apparel Not Permitted

- 1. No shorts, tee-shirts, tank-type shirts, sweatshirts, sweat suits, jogging suits, or similar attire;
- 2. No hats, sunglasses, or outdoor jackets shall be worn when appearing formally before the Court;
- 3. No baggy pants or pants that drag on the ground.
- 4. No mini-skirts or "mini" dresses

B. Encouraged Dress Code

- 1. No provocative attire;
- 2. Shirt and tie for males;
- 3. Pants other than blue jeans;
- 4. Neat and clean shoes.

II. OTHER COURTROOM RESTRICTIONS

A. NO CAMERAS, VIDEO CAMERAS, OR ANY OTHER RECORDING **DEVICES** are allowed in the Courthouse.

- 1. Students and/or volunteers will be allowed into the courthouse with a cellphone, but it shall be off or silenced. No recording of any kind in the courthouse.
- 2. The Genesee County Bar Association, its attorney members, and/or staff will not be responsible for lodging any cameras or video recording equipment that are brought to the courthouse by students or volunteers.
- B. **NO WEAPONS** are allowed in the Courthouse such as explosives, chemical or aerosol sprays or cutting instruments of any kind including knives, scissors or anything with a sharp or cutting edge.
- C. **NO FOOD OR DRINK** whatsoever shall be brought into the courtroom.
- D. Courtroom tables may not be moved. If chairs are moved, they must be returned to their original location.
- E. Programs and all other materials must be removed upon completion of the Mock Trial.
