

COURTHOUSE RULES

I. DRESS CODE

A. Apparel Not Permitted

1. No shorts, tee-shirts, tank-type shirts, sweatshirts, sweat suits, jogging suits, or similar attire;
2. No hats, sunglasses, or outdoor jackets shall be worn when appearing formally before the Court;
3. No baggy pants or pants that drag on the ground.
4. No mini-skirts or “mini” dresses

B. Encouraged Dress Code

1. No provocative attire;
2. Shirt and tie for males;
3. Pants other than blue jeans;
4. Neat and clean shoes.

II. OTHER COURTROOM RESTRICTIONS

A. **NO CAMERAS, VIDEO CAMERAS, OR ANY OTHER RECORDING DEVICES** are allowed in the Courthouse.

1. Students and/or volunteers will be allowed into the courthouse with a cellphone, but it shall be off or silenced. No recording of any kind in the courthouse.
2. The Genesee County Bar Association, its attorney members, and/or staff will not be responsible for lodging any cameras or video recording equipment that are brought to the courthouse by students or volunteers.

B. **NO WEAPONS** are allowed in the Courthouse such as explosives, chemical or aerosol sprays or cutting instruments of any kind including knives, scissors or anything with a sharp or cutting edge.

C. **NO FOOD OR DRINK** whatsoever shall be brought into the courtroom.

D. Courtroom tables may not be moved. If chairs are moved, they must be returned to their original location.

E. Programs and all other materials must be removed upon completion of the Mock Trial.
