Neithercut Legal Education Fund

The Neithercut Fund of the Genesee County Bar Foundation is committed to the continuing legal education of our members who are either sole practitioners or members of law firms. This year the Foundation has increased the scholarship benefits for our members. The Board of the Foundation policy is to encourage seminar participation. Beginning December 1, 2020 and until further notice, the Neithercut Fund of the Genesee County Bar Foundation will now pay for 60% of the cost of tuition per attorney per year, not to exceed \$500 per Attorney per year, to any

To facilitate service of process on the Genesee County Prosecutor's Office (GCPO) we have deployed the email address:

ServiceOnGCPO@geneseecountymi.gov

Instead of using regular mail our office will agree to receive service from attorneys on their CRIMINAL cases, DELINQUENCY cases, and NEGLECT-ABUSE cases. We agree that this email service will comply with MCR 2.107(C)(4) by way of (G) which was added to encourage electronic service of process "to the greatest extent possible."

Of course, mail service and personal service will still be accepted as is traditionally contemplated under the court rules.

MCR 2.107(C) has long provided for the availability of electronic service if the parties in an individual case agreed. Doing so in every criminal case is untenable. Therefore, we hope this offer will assist us as we interact in the interests of justice AND efficiency. I have outlined the major provisions below which were contemplated by MCR 2.107(C) for parties agreeing to electronic service.

If you are including large videos with your text documents, please contact our office at 810-257-3210 BEFORE sending same via email, as it may be too large to be received. An alternative arrangement will need to be made.

Within the subject line, please include the classification of the filing you are serving (e.g., MOTION, ORDER, BRIEF etc.) Def/Juvenile Last name, first name and case number if you have it. On Neglect-Abuse cases, indicate case name (i.e., "In re ____) and the party submitting correspondence.

Please send the documents in PDF format so that there is no concern that something has been altered.

Signatures may be attached or signed in accordance with MCR 1.109(E).

If the transmission is sent at or before 11:59 pm, it shall be deemed served that day. If sent on a Saturday, Sunday, legal holiday, or other day of court closure pursuant to court order, then it will be deemed served the next business day, per MCR 2.107(C)(4)(g).

Please retain "send receipts" until the conclusion of the case. If you receive an undeliverable message after attempting electronic service, you may try again later, but you may need to serve via traditional methods if time is of the essence. Please retain any messages received that the message and its contents were undeliverable.

Feel free to courtesy copy (cc) the APA you believe to be assigned to the case. By using the above email, instead of only sending to a specific APA, this ensures that the documents will pass through our clerical team's hands so that correct docketing entries will occur, and your filings will be linked to our official file and will reach the correct APA (in case your initial belief was in error).

Hopefully, this will save time and money for us all and make us more responsive to each other, the courts, and those we serve.


