Neithercut Legal Education Fund

The Neithercut Fund of the Genesee County Bar Foundation is committed to the continuing legal education of our members who are either sole practitioners or members of law firms. This year the Foundation has increased the scholarship benefits for our members. The Board of the Foundation policy is to encourage seminar participation.



Beginning December 1, 2020 and until further notice, the Neithercut Fund of the Genesee County Bar Foundation will now pay for 60% of the cost of tuition per attorney per year, not to exceed \$500 per Attorney per year, to any

This is not a need-based scholarship but a benefit available to every member whether they pay for their CLE or it is paid by their firm or partnership.

COURTHOUSE SQUARE CENTENNIAL ARTS PROJECT



The Historic Genesee County Courthouse 1926-2026

<u>WHAT</u>: The Genesee County Bar Foundation and the Genesee County Circuit Court have committed to erect a monumental size symbol of the law on the Courthouse Square in a location to be approved by the Genesee County Board of Commissioners.

WHEN: To be formally dedicated September 2026.

WHERE: Courthouse Square

<u>WHO</u>: The Greater Flint Arts Council (GFAC) will join as a collaborating partner to assist with solicitations for proposals and project management.

<u>FUNDING</u>: The GCBF established the *Courthouse Square Centennial Arts Project Fund* with a contribution of \$30,000 from the McGregor Trust Funds, to honor the legal profession and uphold the highest level of professionalism in the community.

The Courthouse Square Project completed in 2003, featured a 3-day celebration of public events with a ticketed gala evening event, raising funds to support ongoing maintenance of the restored Courthouse. The Chief Judge authorized \$30,000 of the privately raised funds to be set aside for this project.

Fundraising Goal: \$100,000.

Sponsors will receive recognition in a prominently displayed location on the Courthouse Square.


All other 67th District Court locations will be open for business for anyone wishing to file papers or make payments.




