(Pursuant to MCR 2.404 (B) (5) all current case evaluators must re-apply every 7 years)

During the month of February 2013 the 7th Judicial Circuit Court is accepting applications from individuals who wish to serve as case evaluators. This is done in accordance with our Local Administrative Order 2009-8J and MCR 2.404.

To serve as a case evaluator you must meet the following minimum qualifications:

- You must have been a practicing lawyer for at least 5 years.
- You must be a member in good standing of the State Bar of Michigan.
- You must reside, maintain an office, or have an active practice in Genesee County
- You must demonstrate that a substantial portion of your practice for the last 5 years has been devoted to civil litigation matters including investigation, discovery, motion practice, case evaluation, settlement, trial preparation, and/or trial.
- You must have attended a case evaluator training session seminar offered by the Genesee County Bar Association (This is intended for applicants who have **never** served as a case evaluator. Training to be scheduled in April 2013)

If you are applying for one of the court maintained sublists (see below) you must have an active practice in that area

Individuals should submit a completed Case Evaluator Application (MC34). This form is available on the web page of the State Court Administrative Office (<http://courts.michigan.gov/Administration/SCAO/Forms/Pages/Case-Evaluation.aspx>).

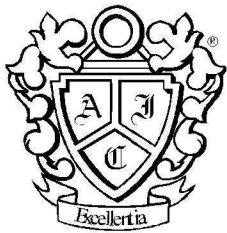

The Executive Committee of the Centennial American Inn of Court will select a recipient using the following protocol.

Nomination

The Executive Committee will solicit nominations from the membership of the Genesee County Bar Association at GCBA membership meetings and through the monthly GCBA newsletter.

Selection

The Executive Committee will consider nominations every year, but the Committee might not select an award recipient every year. The factors considered by the Committee will include:

The use of novel and effective legal arguments or techniques;

The willingness to represent unpopular clients or causes;

The willingness to recognize and promote the interests of the client, including the promotion of settlement or alternative dispute resolution where appropriate;

The promotion of respect for the legal profession and the judicial system by cooperation with all participants in the legal system, including court personnel, opposing counsel, opposing clients, witnesses, and the public; and

Recognition of his/her stewardship in the judicial system by avoidance of conduct that disparages the Courts and its officials and other counsel.

Award

A recipient of the award will be recognized by the President of the Inn at the GCBA annual meeting. The Inn will provide a suitable plaque at its expense.
