Law Day - Mock Trials

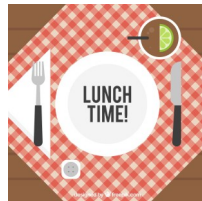

Genesee County Bar Foundation Scholarship Opportunities

Neithercut Legal Education Fund

The Neithercut Fund of the Genesee County Bar Foundation is committed to the continuing legal education of our members who are either sole practitioners or members of law firms. This year the Foundation has increased the scholarship benefits for our members. The Board of the Foundation policy is to encourage seminar participation.

Beginning December 1, 2020 and until further notice, the Neithercut Fund of the Genesee County Bar Foundation will now pay for 60% of the cost of tuition per attorney per year, not to exceed \$500 per Attorney per year, to any

- Institute of Continuing Legal Education (ICLE) Seminar of the State Bar of Michigan (SBM);
- American Bankruptcy Institute;
- Federal Bar Association Bankruptcy Section;
- Criminal Defense Attorneys of Michigan; and

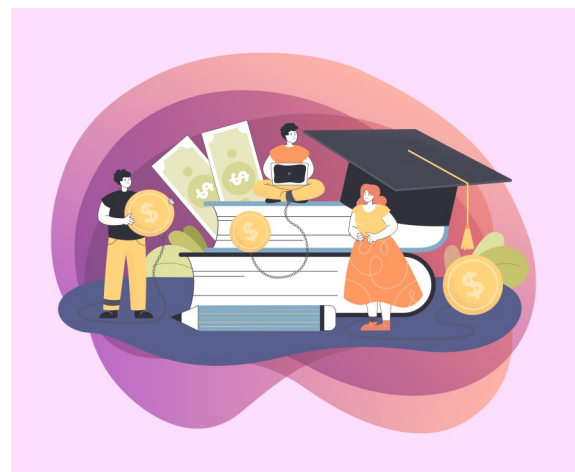

This Special Meeting shall precede the regular monthly membership luncheon for the following purpose:

To vote on an amendment to the bylaws of the Genesee County Bar Association to allow for the addition of a Dissolution clause stating where our assets would go if our organization dissolved.

Proposed Bylaw Amendment

Upon the dissolution of the Association and the winding up of its affairs, the remaining assets of the Association, after satisfaction of or reservation for all liabilities of the Association, shall be distributed to The Genesee County Bar Foundation and/or to such other nonprofit organizations recognized as tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, as the Board of Directors shall determine.

Please plan to attend this Special Meeting. A quorum of 45 members is required to transact business at any meeting. This attendance can be in person, via the telephone, or electronically.

Immediately following this Special Meeting, the Monthly Membership Meeting will begin approximately at 12:30 p.m., featuring Dayna Harper, Executive Director of the Community Resolution Center.
